Macs was established in 1965 as a light fabrication company. In the early 1980's the company started to manufacture heavy duty utility bodies primarily for the mining industry. Today Macs employs some 95 staff based on adjoining sites, primarily servicing customers in Central Queensland, the Bowen Basin and North Queensland.

Due to the current mining boom in QLD many companies have experienced skills shortages. We made a decision in 2005 to start recruiting overseas as we could not find the skills we needed from the local market.

To facilitate this process for us we started working with Four Corners Emigration. They seemed well positioned to assist us and our candidates as they had offices in Australia as well as in the UK & South Africa.
